

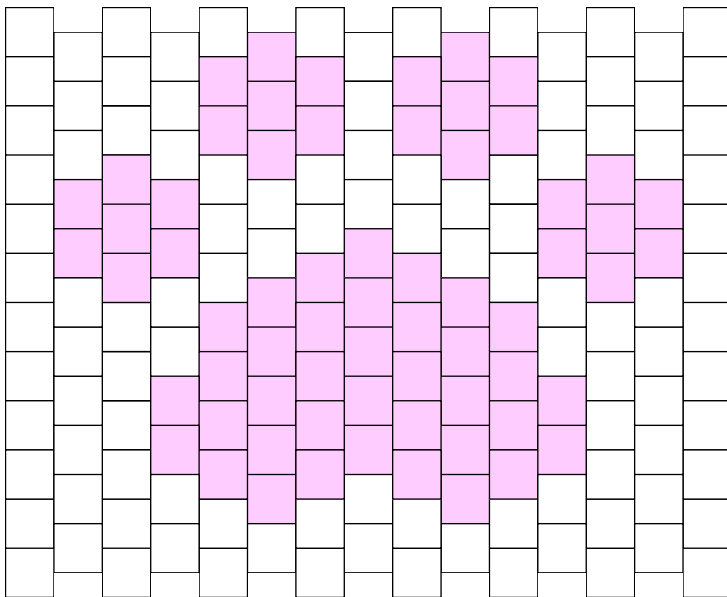


Paw-Some Tea Party Paw Pattern

The paw design is 15 beads wide and the repeat is 23 rows. The beading measures 20mm wide and the repeat is 19mm deep.

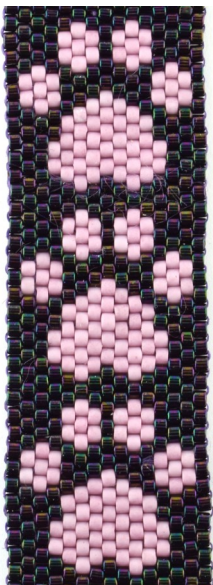
This paw bracelet has been woven using **odd count peyote stitch**. Working from either the top or bottom of the diagram, keep repeating the pattern until your bracelet is long enough.

We have a useful YouTube video showing you how to start peyote stitch and how to do odd count peyote stitch. We've also got a video showing you how to add the E-hook clasp.

Materials used for this example

- Miyuki Delica beads in DB004 Purple Iris
- Miyuki Delica beads in DB335 Matte Rose
- Size 10 beading needle
- Nymo thread
- 13mm E hook



Tip; once you've attached the clasp to your bracelet check the length before adding the loop, you don't want your bracelet too long or short!
