Mini Beaded Flowers






Materials (Makes 1 flower) 8 x Superduo Beads 8 x Size 8 Seed Beads 24 x Size 11 Seed Beads 50cm x Beading Thread (Nymo, Wildfire, Fireline, SoNo or KO). Beading Needle (Size 10).

Step 1

Thread all 8 Superduo beads onto your thread. Then tie the ends of the thread together (leaving a 7cm tail on one side) creating a circle. Thread the short tail through a few beads then cut the excess off.



Step 2

Thread through the second hole in the Superduo bead you are exiting, going back on yourself and add 1 size 8 seed bead in between each Superduo bead. End by threading through the first size 8 seed bead added.

Step 3

Pick up 3 size 11 seed beads, anchor through the next size 8 and continue the whole way around the circle. End by anchoring through the first size 8 seed bead and fasten off the end with a knot around the thread, weave through a few beads before cutting off the excess.

These flower are ideal for earrings, linking together to make bracelets or an elegant necklace. Here's a few examples...



Why not make more of a statement and bead your flowers together to create a bracelet. This would also work well to make a necklace.

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
